Installation Instructions

Installation and fitment instructions includes the tools required, fasteners included in the kit, and the hardware included in the kit.

Please follow the instructions and check installation steps with the images in this document.

Alu-Cab recommends that all sealing work is allowed to cure for 24 hours, after which you may drive the vehicle on normal paved roads. Before driving off-road with your Alu-Cab product or operating your roof conversion, an additional cure period of 48 hours is required.

Failure to follow these instructions will void your warranty. Please ensure that you follow the sealant manufacturers curing time as per their technical data sheet.

These times may differ slightly from the times we have recommended.

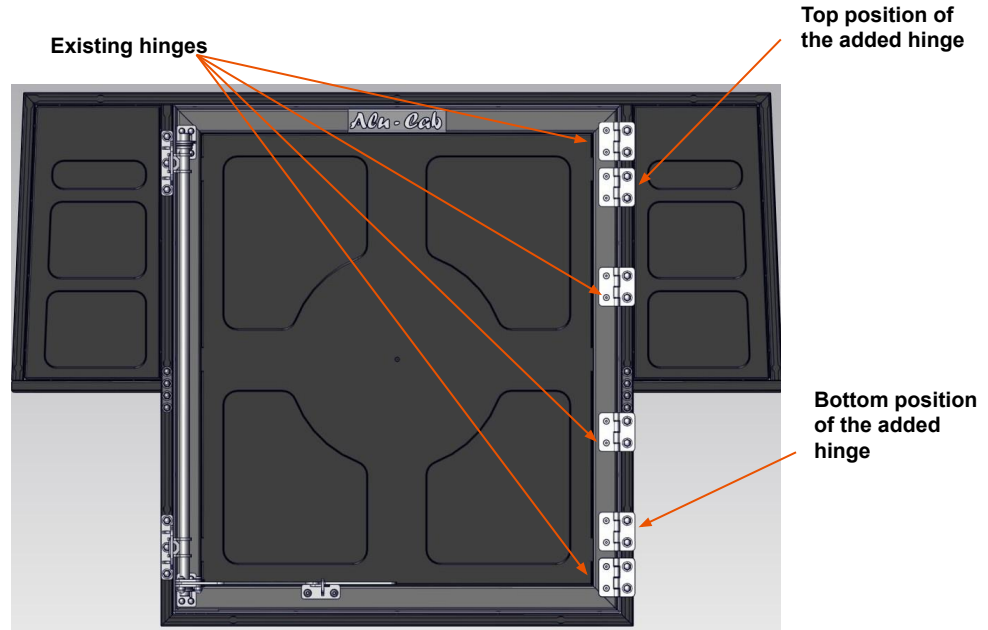

8mm Drill bit

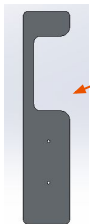

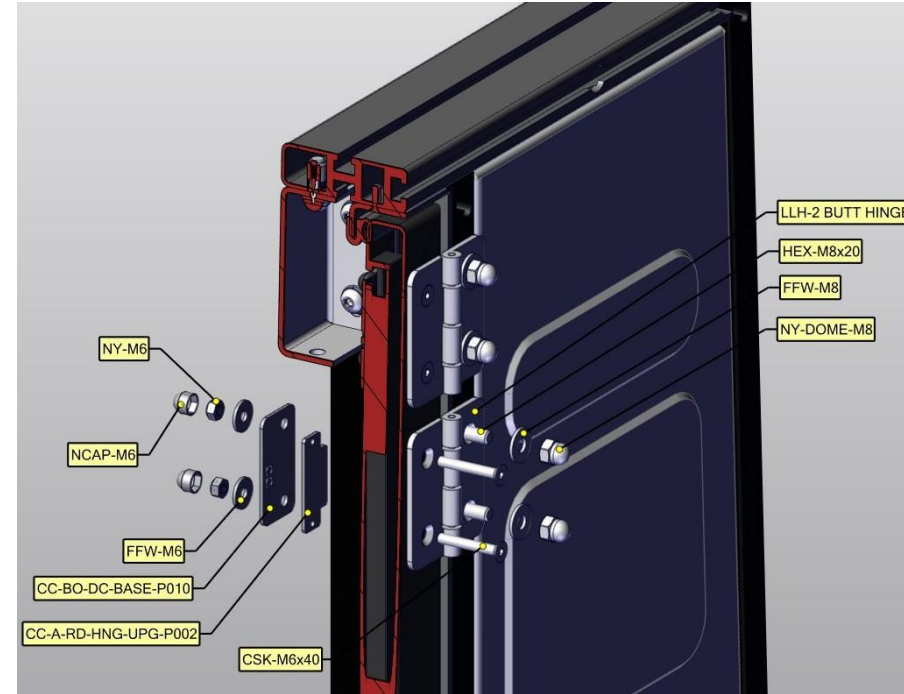

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How to install the rear door Top hinge

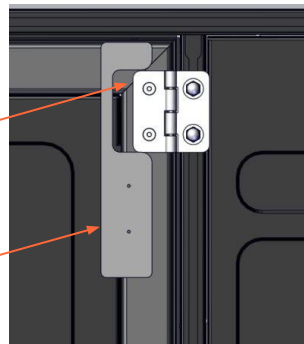
STEP 1 : Slide the hinge template provided over the Top hinge as shown in the image on the right.

STEP 2 : Make sure the hinge template is straight up against the Top hinge. Check that the pilot holes of the template are in line with the top hinge holes on the door side.

STEP 3 : Mark the pilot holes and drill the holes with a 3mm drill bit through the rear door tubing.

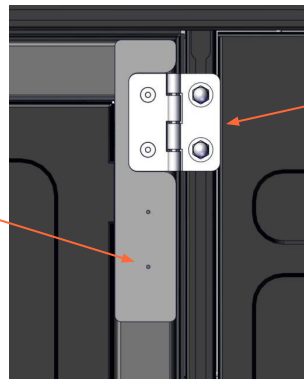
Top Butt hinge

Complete fit

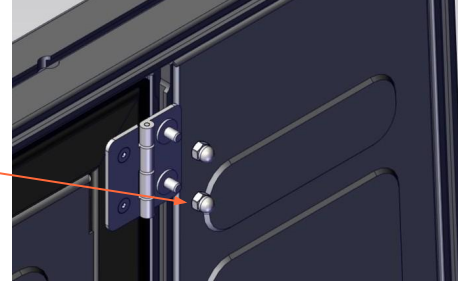

STEP 4 : Loosen and remove the Top hinge M8 Nyloc Dome Nut with 13mm Spanner.

M8 NYLOC DOME NUT

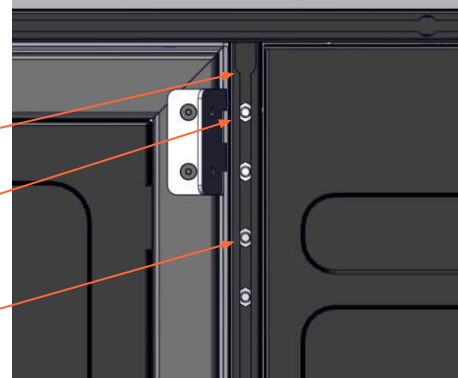


STEP 5 : Slide the existing M8 Hex bolts down and insert two of the supplied M8 Hex bolts into the nut slot from the top.

Existing M8 hex bolt



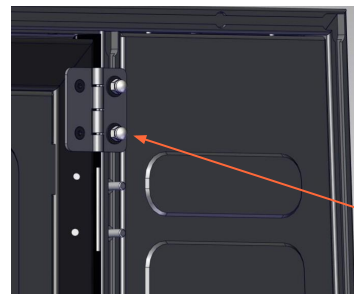

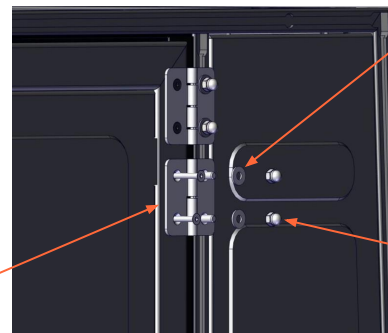
STEP 6 : Insert and fasten the Top hinge M8 Dome Nuts with 13mm spanner to secure the top hinge back into place.

STEP 7 : Use the 6mm drill bit to drill the 3mm pilot holes to a 6mm hole size.

STEP 8 : First drill the holes on the RHS of the New Butt Hinge to 8mm in order for the M8 bolt to fit. Then mount the new hinges to the Base with the M8 bolts, flat washer. Check if the drilled holes line up correctly with the hole position.

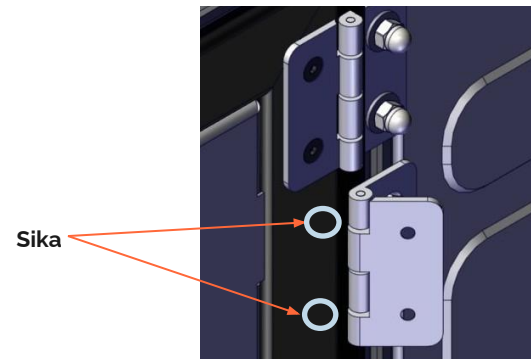

STEP 9 : Add some sika around the holes on the rear door. This will prevent water leakages.



STEP 10 : After the sika application, flip the hinge in position for the M6 countersunk screws to be placed through the holes.

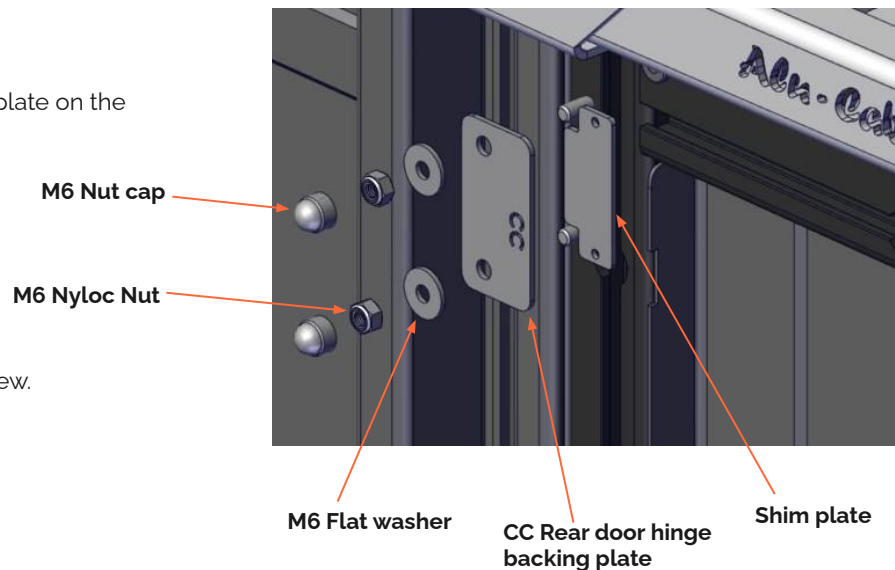

STEP 11 : Place the Shim plate and rear door hinge backing plate on the inside of the rear door and over the countersunk screws.

STEP 12 : Place the M6 flat washer over the countersunk screw.

STEP 13 : Use M6 Nyloc nuts to fasten the hinge in place.

STEP 14 : Use the M6 Nut cap to cover the M6 Nyloc nuts.

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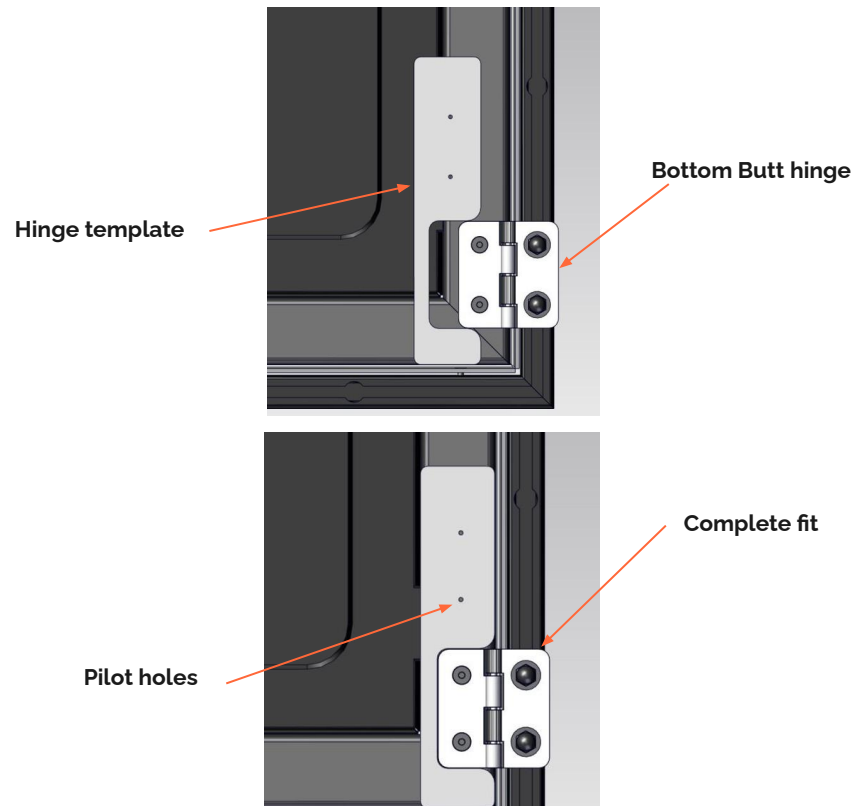
How to install the rear door Bottom hinge

STEP 1 : Slide the hinge template provided over the Bottom hinge as shown in the image on the right.

STEP 2 : Make sure the hinge template is straight up against the Bottom hinge. Check that the pilot holes of the template are in line with the Bottom hinge holes on the door side.

STEP 3 : Mark the pilot holes and drill the holes with a 3mm drill bit through the rear door tubing.

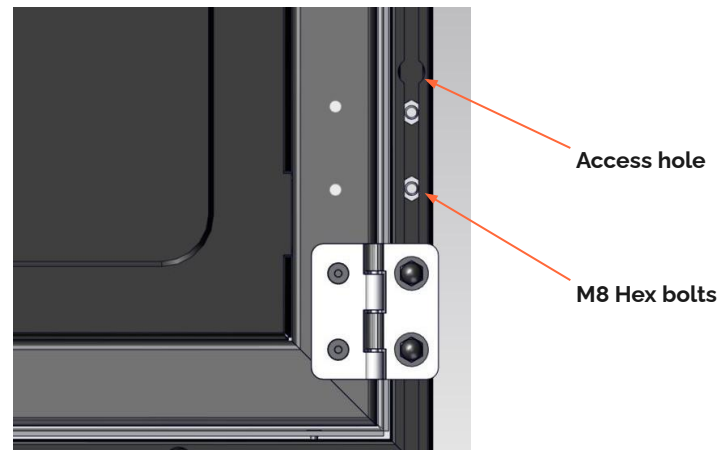
STEP 4 : Use the 6mm drill bit to drill the 3mm pilot holes to a 6mm hole size.



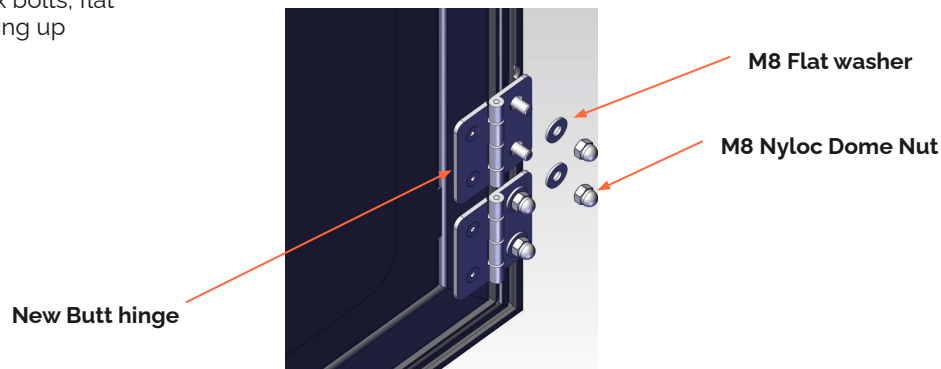

STEP 5 : Insert two M8 Hex bolts through the access hole and slide the M8 Hex bolts down into position.



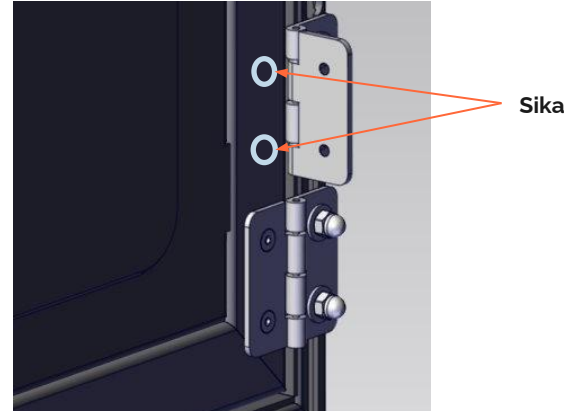
STEP 6 : First mount the new hinges to the Base with the M8 Hex bolts, flat washers and Nyloc Dome Nuts. Check if the drilled holes are lining up correctly with the hinge hole position..



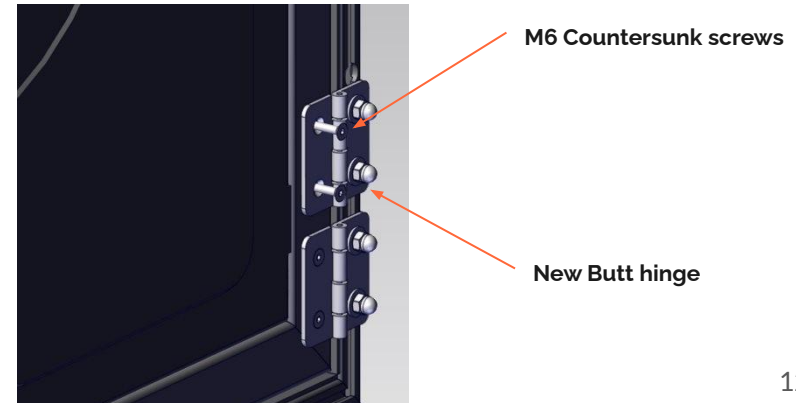

STEP 7 : Add some sika around the holes on the rear door. This will prevent water leakages.



STEP 8 : After the sika application, flip the hinge in position for the M6 countersunk screws to be placed through the holes.

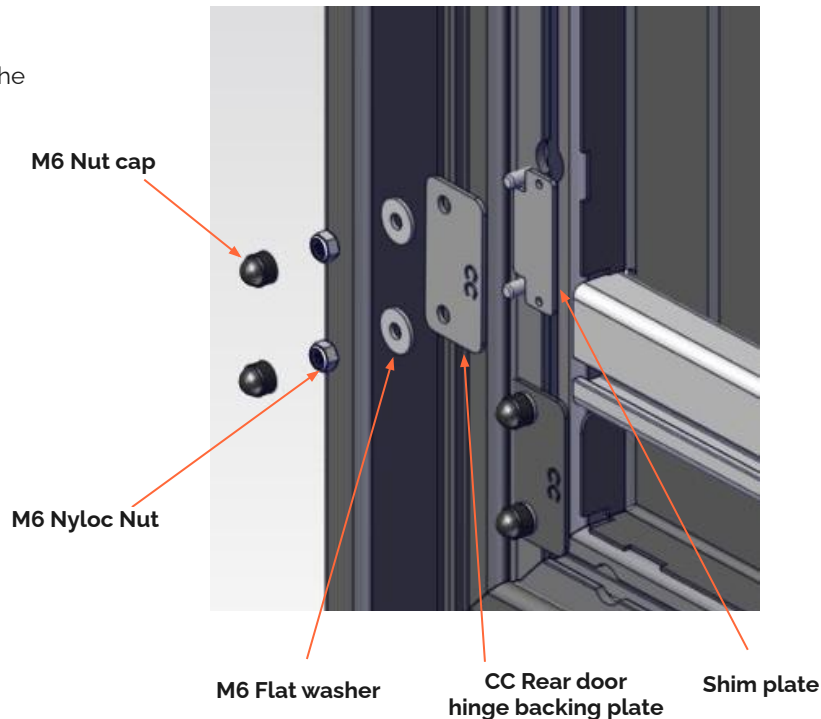

STEP 10 : Place the M6 flat washer over the countersunk screw.

STEP 11 : Use M6 Nyloc nuts to fasten the hinge in place.

STEP 12 : Use the M6 Nut cap to cover the M6 Nyloc nuts.
